DESCRIPTION

BCSP and the BCSP Foundation are committed in supporting the pursuit or maintenance of schools' accreditation through the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET) or Aviation Accreditation Board International (AABI). BCSP provides monetary contributions to our QAPs to aid in accreditation costs. Students of ABET-accredited QAPs are further eligible for scholarships provided by the BCSP Foundation.

SCHOLARSHIP TYPES

- A GSP QAP is eligible for a grant of up to \$10,000 toward full accreditation or reaccreditation under the ABET
- The BCSP Foundation provides ABET/AABI accredited QAPs with \$5,000 scholarships for their students
- The BCSP Foundation provides an annual monetary contribution to QAP programs that are accredited by ABET/ AABI to assist in yearly accreditation costs
